



## Applying for a semester-long ACICIS program at Flinders University

### Important:

Before applying at [acicis.edu.au/apply-now](https://acicis.edu.au/apply-now), please consider the following:

### 1 Eligibility

As a full time undergraduate student, an applicant should at the time of application:

- have achieved an overall GPA of 5.0 following completion of one semester (18 units) of their current program of study; or
- have achieved an overall GPA of 4.0 following completion of (or about to complete) at least one year of their current program of study (36 units);
- are enrolled as a full-time student.

### 2 Tuition fees

The ACICIS tuition fees are paid by Flinders University directly to the ACICIS Secretariat. Payment will be approved following confirmation of credit from the College Office and approval to enrol in one of XOTH2102 or XOTH2102A.

### 3 New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

To be eligible for the **New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant**, students need to apply for a relevant program. ACICIS will then assess the eligibility of the grant and the student will be awarded the grant if he/she meets all of the criteria:

- An Australian citizen,
- enrolled in an on-shore Australian University throughout the duration of the Mobility Project,
- be undertaking a Bachelor Degree or Bachelor Honours Degree at the commencement of the Mobility Project,
- receiving credit for participation in the Mobility Project,
- has not previously received a short-term New Colombo Plan grant
- is not a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia, and
- 70% of grant recipients for any given ACICIS program must be aged 18-28

### 4 Application deadlines

Application Due	Semester 1 Programs (Feb – June)	Semester 2 Programs (Aug – Dec)
ACICIS Application	All Programs: 1 October (year prior)	<b>DSIP, FLIP:</b> 15 March (same year) <b>ASP, IBLS, IRP:</b> 15 April (same year)

### 5 Application process

**Step 1:** Prior to applying directly to ACICIS, students are required to seek credit approval from the relevant College Office: <http://www.flinders.edu.au/international-students/student-exchange-study-abroad/outbound/how-to-apply/college-office.cfm>

Once your eligibility and credit approval is confirmed, you can commence your ACICIS application with the following steps:

**Step 2:** Submit your online application at [www.acicis.edu.au/apply-now](http://www.acicis.edu.au/apply-now). You will be issued with a preliminary approval into your chosen program and will receive further instructions regarding the next steps involved.

**Step 3:** Once you have completed the ACICIS Visa & Pre-Departure forms, ACICIS will be in touch to confirm your acceptance onto the program.

**Step 4:** Following receipt of acceptance from ACICIS, the Learn Without Borders team will arrange to enroll accepted students into a specific Flinders University topic code.

**Step 5:** ACICIS will work with Flinders University to confirm student's eligibility for the New Colombo Plan and if successful students will be contacted by ACICIS to facilitate payment of your grant.

### 6 Travel Insurance

Flinders University students are covered by the university travel insurance for up to 180 days, free of charge.
